**New TurboJET Check-in Counter**

**Official Launch of Upstream Airline Check-in Service**

(10 December 2007 - Macau) With customer satisfaction in mind, TurboJET has constantly offered new services to suit different needs. To provide a more comfortable and efficient journey for passengers on the airport routes, TurboJET is introducing new check-in counters at The New Macau Ferry Terminal. At the same time, its one-stop upstream airline check-in service is launched in association with several airlines to facilitate a carefree trip for passengers.

To celebrate the occasion, TurboJET held a celebration ceremony this afternoon at The New Macau Ferry Terminal. It marks the formal launch of both the airport routes check-in counters and upstream airline check-in service. Guests of honor include Director of Port Authority of Macau SAR Ms. Wong Soi Man, Airport Management Director of Airport Authority Hong Kong Mr. YF Wong, Mr. Hideki Moriyama, General Manager of Vice President- Asia & Oceania Region of Japan Airlines International Co. Ltd., Mr. Masashi Fukuda, Regional Manager of Japan Airlines HK, Macau and Southern China and Deputy General Manager of Shun Tak- China Travel Ship Management Limited Ms. Anna Hong.

The number of airport routes check-in counters is increased from three to six to reinforce processing capacity. Equipments have been upgraded including TV screens to show sailing information, as well as an expanded waiting area to facilitate passengers' convenience.

Moreover, TurboJET has cooperated with Hong Kong International Airport, Cathay Pacific Airways Limited, Hong Kong Dragon Airlines Limited and Japan Airlines International Co. Ltd to provide one-stop upstream airline check-in service for passengers, enabling their luggage to be transferred directly to the destination. When passengers register at New Macau Ferry Terminal, they can check in their luggage,

with the added convenience of proceeding boarding procedures for their transit flights to save time. Earlier in June, TurboJET has started trail runs with Cathay Pacific and Dragonair on the service, with Japan Airlines joining in September. After months of soft operation, the service is launched today. More airline partners will be joining the service in the upcoming months. Passengers departing from Macau and transiting via the Shenzhen International Airport can also enjoy the same convenience with our 10 participating airline partners.

At the occasion, Deputy General Manager of Shun Tak- China Travel Ship Management Limited Ms. Anna Hong remarks, “TurboJET will continue to come out with diversified services in association with passengers’ practical needs. We are also dedicated to strengthen connectivity of Macau with the rest of the world, as well as passenger transportation services between the Pearl River Delta.”

Mr Y F Wong, General Manager - Landside Business of Airport Authority Hong Kong, said, “Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) is committed to strengthening its transportation ties with the Pearl River Delta. Since the launch of the upstream check-in service, passengers can travel via HKIA in a hassle-free manner for their onward direct flights to over 150 destinations. Apart from Macau, passengers leaving from Shekou and Fuyong ports in Shenzhen can also enjoy the service.”
