TurboJET to launch new HKIA - Macau Taipa route Extending its edge in pan-regional transportation network

(14 December, 2009 – Hong Kong, Macau) TurboJET announced today the launch of its new service between Hong Kong International Airport and Macau's Taipa Temporary Ferry Terminal (HKIA-TTFT). Starting tomorrow, international flight passengers departing from Macau Taipa can make use of TurboJET Airport Route and transit at the newly completed permanent Skypier facility at HKIA to their final destination, without the hassle of clearing Hong Kong customs or immigration.

TurboJET's multi-modal transportation network is complemented by the inclusion of Taipa into its many destinations. The new permanent Skypier facility features additional dedicated check-in counters and a new baggage handling system, as well as an Automated People Mover system that connects passengers directly to the terminals. The new facility allows TurboJET to offer an upgraded transit experience for all air-sea passengers.

In addition to increased sailings between Hong Kong International Airport and Macau Maritime Ferry Terminal announced earlier, the newly launched HKIA-TTFT route is part of TurboJET's sailing enhancement initiative. Adding Taipa Temporary Ferry Terminal to its growing destination network in the Pearl River Delta, TurboJET offers excellent and efficient connections between Macau and various international destinations, complementing the ever-growing tourism and civic development of the city. The new route enhances economic unity of the region and increases the tie between Macau, Hong Kong, the Pearl River Delta Region and other popular destinations around the world.

At its initial launch phase, the new route offers daily services at 10:00am from HKIA to TTFT and 4:30pm from TTFT to HKIA. Ticket fares for the 50-minute journey are identical to TurboJET's Hong Kong International Airport – Macau Maritime Ferry Terminal route.
