TurboJET boosted its Schedule Additional Sailings for its Hong Kong—Macau Airport Route

(20 November 2009—Hong Kong & Macau) TurboJET announced today, effective 21 November 2009, sailings between Hong Kong International Airport and Macau Maritime Ferry Terminal (HKIA-MMFT) will be increased and adjusted to tie-in closely with the peak flight landing and taking off hours, so as to meet the rising demands of the discerning crowd. With the enhanced schedule, its Hong Kong—Macau Airport route will be operated with approximately one sailing per hour.

This latest sailing adjustment is the first phase of TurboJET's sailing enhancement exercise, which runs in line with the completion of the upcoming permanent facilities of the SkyPier at the Hong Kong International Airport. The HKIA-MMFT route will eventually operate with a total of 25 sailings by early next year. TurboJET is set to extend the sailing enhancement effort to other routes, in order to strengthen its service network and the overall connectivity of the whole Region.
