**TurboJET of Shun Tak – China Travel announced  
changes and increases sailing schedule on Macau and Shenzhen route**

(Hong Kong, 06 September 2003) TurboJET of Shun Tak – China Travel (ST-CT) announced that from 10 September onwards, a new sailing schedule with the daily sailing increment from 4 to 8 sailings on the Macau and Shenzhen route will be applied.

# Optional Sailing

ST-CT reported that demand on service of Macau and Shenzhen route has been steadily increased since its official launch last year. Healthy growth on passenger ferry service and increase of mobility in the Pearl River Delta region were expected from the signing of CEPA, the China joining in the WTO and the open up on its travel policy; besides, the opening of our new route between Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) and Macau SAR and Shenzhen by the end of September will create a new source of passenger. It is expected that the new increase sailings will facilitate the market demand and enhance the transportation network between three major cities in the Pearl River Delta region, Hong Kong SAR, Shenzhen and Macau SAR and will be favorable for both tourist and business travelers.

ST-CT will introduce a new brand “TurboJET Sea Express” serving the new link

between the HKIA and Macau and Shenzhen, targeted to be operational by the end of September. This pioneer service develops a fast and convenient inter-modal connection in the region facilitating transit passengers en route HKIA between Macau and overseas countries. Passengers do not need to undergo any Customs and Immigration formalities when arrive at HKIA for their transit flight and hassle free from delivering their luggage to the ferry terminal. It shortens the distance between Macau, Shenzhen and HKIA and popular airports in the Pearl River Delta region, the HKIA, Macau International Airport and Shenzhen Baoan International Airport will also be linked up, providing more frequent choices of connection flights for transit passengers and will definitely further enhance the transportation network the region as well as strengthening the position of Pearl River Delta region as a whole.

TurboJET provides the safest, the most reliable and efficient high-speed passenger ferry service. Complimentary shuttle bus service is provided to connect passenger from the Shenzhen Fu Yong Ferry Terminal and Boan Airport, which is merely a few minutes ride. Additionally, in response to demand from passengers using this route, complimentary shuttle bus service connecting Fu Yong Ferry Terminal and Metropole Service Apartment (Shenzhen), Hotel Oriental Regent and Seaview Hotel in the city is specially arranged lately.
