**“Macau Amorous Feelings”
A Cheng Exhibition Unveiling Ceremony**

(October 30, 2009 – HK & Macau) In celebration of the 10th anniversary of the Macau S.A.R., which coincides with the 10th birthday of the TurboJET brand, TurboJET organized the “Macau Amorous Feelings” A Cheng Exhibition’ to bring viewers back to the old scenes of life in Macau. The renowned Macanese water-painting illustrator, A Cheng, was invited to use his brushstrokes and various featured showpieces to display for the public the changes brought by time as well as to relive diverse traditional culture and customs in Macau. The Exhibition was unveiled on the Ground floor at the Times Square today.

On the set of old Macau, “Macau Amorous Feelings” A Cheng Exhibition presents 60 ink water paintings on the 2/F and G/F of Times Square, picturing all the traditional Macanese customs and practices retrieved from the painter’s memory. The exhibits are presented under 5 different themes and in a setting that recreates the façade and cobble-stoned streets of Macau. The Exhibition is open to the public from today till 8th November. Following the exhibition at the Times Square, the mobile gallery will continue its tour to various venues including Shun Tak Centre and the Macau Tower.

This afternoon, Ms. Pansy Ho, Chief Executive Officer of TurboJET together with Mr. Stanley Mok, General Manager of the Hong Kong Representative Office of Macau Government Tourist Office, A Cheng, Mr. Vernon Ma, Promotions and Advertising Manager of Times Square Limited and Soler, the Macanese pop artistes, hosted the unveiling ceremony. Ms. Pansy Ho, in her welcoming speech, said, “We are honored to be a part of the ten-year development of the Macau S.A.R since its establishment. This year, in a coincidence, the TurboJET brand is also celebrating its 10th birthday. By this Exhibition the public can, once again, experience the traditional Macanese features and recall the snap shots of life in old Macau.”
