TurboJET further boosting service to Guangzhou (Nansha)

(13 Jul 2010 – Macau) Shortly following last month’s launch of a new route connecting Guangzhou (Nansha) and Macau Maritime Ferry Terminal, Shun Tak China Travel Ship Management Limited celebrated yet another collaboration with Panyu Nansha Port Passenger Port Transport Co., Ltd today, launching new sailings between Guangzhou (Nansha) and Macau’s Taipa Temporary Ferry Terminal. From now on, sailings between Macau and Guangzhou will be increased to 4 trips per day.

This morning, Ms. Susana Wong Soi-man, Director of Maritime Administration of Macau SAR joined Mr. Fok Kam To, General Manager of Panyu Nansha Port Passenger Transport Co., Ltd and Ms. Anna Hong, Deputy General Manager of Shun Tak-China Travel Ship Management Limited in a ritual ceremony blessing the maiden voyage of the new service.

In its initial launch phase, the new route offers services at 10:15 a.m. from Nansha to Macau and 11:45 a.m. from Macau’s Taipa Temporary Ferry Terminal to Nansha. As an introductory offer, customers will be entitled to a 50% discount on the purchase of an Economy Class round-trip ticket on the new route:
